

ORDINANCE NO. 332

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 30 of Chapter 31 of the Alexandria City Code, enacted July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940 by repealing and re-enacting the heading and introductory paragraph to said section and by adding an additional paragraph to said section.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That the heading and introductory paragraph of Section 30 of Chapter 31 of the Alexandria City Code be repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

"Sec. 30. Tourist and trailer camps and recreational parks.

Every person who shall operate, maintain, offer for use, or permit to be used within the city any tract of land for a camp or park for habitation, temporary or permanent, for rest, recreation, amusement or educational purposes shall comply with the following regulations:"

Section 2. That Section 30 of Chapter 31 of Alexandria City Code be amended by the addition of the following paragraph after paragraph (1):

"(m) No trailer or other similar movable device designed and occupied for habitation shall be parked, stationed, kept or located on any premises within the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria except within a trailer camp or park for which permission has been granted by the City Council, which has been approved by the city health department and which has been licensed by the Commissioner of Revenue."

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
