

ORDINANCE NO. 340

AN ORDINANCE prohibiting dancing in certain establishments within the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That dancing is hereby prohibited in any establishment within the City of Alexandria, Virginia, other than a duly licensed hotel, where beer, wine or any similar beverage is sold or consumed upon the premises. The prohibition contained in this ordinance shall apply against the owner or operator of any such establishment as well as against the participants in the act of dancing.

Section 2. That any person who shall be found guilty of violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) or be confined in jail for not more than ninety days, or both.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in The Alexandria Gazette.
