

ORDINANCE NO. 343

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 3, Chapter 28 of the City Code of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted July 2, 1940.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That the "Revised Zoning Map" described and referred to in Section 3 of Chapter 28 of the Alexandria City Code, enacted as a whole on the 2nd day of July, 1940 and effective August 5, 1940, be and the same is hereby amended in the following particulars so that the pieces of property hereinafter listed are changed to the respective zones specified:

(a) Property at northwest corner of Gibbon and St. Asaph Streets from C-1 Residence Zone to D-2 Commercial Zone.

(b) Plot of ground having a frontage of 95 feet on St. Asaph Street, starting at the intersection of Jefferson Street, located immediately east of the Homestead Tea Room, the frontage on Jefferson Street being 123 feet 5 inches, to C-2 Residence Zone.

(c) Plot of ground located on the east side of St. Asaph Street, running from Jefferson Street to Franklin Street, the frontage on Jefferson and Franklin Streets being 131 feet 10 inches, plus a 15 foot alley, and the frontage on St. Asaph Street being 353 feet, extending from Jefferson Street to Franklin Street, to C-2 Residence Zone.

(d) Lots 24 through 28 and Lots 49 through 55, East Braddock, from A Residence Zone to C-1 Residence Zone.

(e) The following described property from D-2 Commercial Zone to C-2 Residence Zone:

"Beginning on the east line of Washington Street 125 feet south of its intersection of the south line of Franklin Street and running thence easterly at right angles to Washington Street to the west line of St. Asaph Street; thence southerly with the west line of St. Asaph Street 131.81 feet; thence leaving St. Asaph Street and running easterly parallel to Jefferson Street 123.42 feet; thence southerly parallel to St. Asaph Street 20 feet; thence westerly 123.42 feet to the east line of Washington Street thence with the east line of Washington Street 153.17 feet to the point of beginning."

(f) East side of Royal Street, between Franklin and Jefferson Streets, from A Residence Zone to C-1 Residence Zone.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
