

ORDINANCE No. 347

AN ORDINANCE to vacate a portion of Walnut Street and a portion of Linden Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is to the best interest of the City of Alexandria to vacate and abandon the following described portions of the following named streets so that public purposes paramount to the use of said streets may be served; now therefore

Section 1. That that portion of Linden Street east of the east line of Mount Vernon Avenue and that portion of Walnut Street east of the east line of Mount Vernon Avenue, all as shown on a print dated April 1, 1941 and prepared in the Office of the City Engineer of Alexandria, be and the same hereby are vacated and abandoned as public streets or thoroughfares.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect simultaneously with the delivery to the City of a deed by the present owners thereof of that part of Lot 22, Section 4, Rosemont, as lies between the boundary line of Mt. Vernon Avenue extended through said lot.
