

ORDINANCE No. 350

AN ORDINANCE to vacate the northerly forty-one feet of Cameron Street lying to the east of Union Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Navy Department of the United States Government has purchased and now owns certain valuable property lying to the south of Cameron Street both to the east and to the west of Union Street within the City of Alexandria, all of which is used as a Naval Torpedo Station; and

WHEREAS, the said Navy Department of the United States Government has acquired certain property lying to the north of Cameron Street and to the east of Union Street in said City and proposes to develop and improve the same for use in connection with the said Naval Torpedo Station; and

WHEREAS, said Navy Department of the United States Government has found it necessary in the interest of National Defense to acquire the use of the northerly forty-one feet of Cameron Street lying to the east of Union Street, to which acquisition adjacent property owners have consented; and

WHEREAS, the said Navy Department of the United States Government has covenanted and agreed to remove all sewers, water mains and other utility lines now located in or under the said northerly forty-one feet of Cameron Street east of Union Street and to re-install the same in the southerly twenty-five feet of Cameron Street east of Union Street.

NOW, THEREFORE:

Section 1. That the northerly forty-one feet of Cameron Street lying to the east of Union Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned as a public thoroughfare or right of way to the use of the Navy Department of the United States Government for purposes in conjunction with the Naval Torpedo Station.

Section 2. That this vacation and abandonment in no way affects the southerly twenty-five feet of Cameron Street lying to the east of Union Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 3. That this vacation and abandonment is made expressly subject to and conditioned upon the execution by the said Navy Department of the United States Government of its covenant and agreement to remove all sewers, water mains and other public utility lines now located in or under the aforesaid northerly forty-one feet of Cameron Street east of Union Street and to re-install all said sewers, water mains and other public utility lines in or under the remaining or southerly twenty-five feet of Cameron Street lying east of Union Street, all in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in The Alexandria Gazette.
