

ORDINANCE No. 351

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia by adding thereto an additional chapter, relating to the issuance of Tax Certificates.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That the Alexandria City Code, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same hereby is amended by the addition of the following chapter:

"CHAPTER VII-A—CERTIFICATES OF TAXES

Sec. 1. The City Collector of Alexandria shall issue, to any applicant therefor, a Certificate setting forth the entire amount of unpaid taxes assessed against any real estate within the City, by or on behalf of the City, up to and including the last day of the calendar year preceding the date of the said Certificate.

Sec. 2. A separate Certificate shall be issued for each separate piece of property as the same appears upon the current Alexandria City Assessment Maps, and a fee of twenty-five cents (25c) shall be charged for each Certificate.

Sec. 3. The facts as set forth in each Certificate shall be binding upon the City of Alexandria, and no taxes other than those reported as unpaid in the said Certificate shall thereafter constitute a lien upon the real estate referred to in the said Certificate.

Sec. 4. The Certificates provided for herein shall be designated "Certificates of Taxes" and shall be substantially in the following form:

I hereby certify that the records in the office of the Tax Collector for the City of Alexandria, Virginia show that all city taxes due against the following property:

known as Lot....., Block....., on Alexandria City Assessment Map.....and assessed in the name of..... are paid in full to....., with the exception of the following:

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in The Alexandria Gazette.
