

ORDINANCE No. 352

AN ORDINANCE to amend Paragraph (7), Subsection B, of Sec. 13 of Article VI of Chapter 28 of the Alexandria City Code enacted July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That Paragraph (7), Subsection B, of Sec. 13 of Article VI of Chapter 28 of the Alexandria City Code, enacted July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

"(7) Sign, advertising only the general business conducted on the premises and not projecting more than four feet beyond the wall of the building upon which placed. Signs may be placed or painted on only the front wall of the building, except a corner building, in which case the side of the building facing the intersecting street shall also be defined as frontage. No sign or signs shall have a larger area in the aggregate than one-tenth of the area of the said front wall of the building."

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in The Alexandria Gazette.
