

ORDINANCE NO. 357

AN ORDINANCE to repeal and re-enact Section 6 of Chapter XXVII of the Alexandria City Code.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That Section 6 of Chapter XXVII of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

"Sec 6. **Plumbing board.** The plumbing board shall consist of the City Health Officer, City Engineer, City Building Inspector and the City Plumbing Inspector by virtue of their offices, one master plumber, one journeyman plumber and two citizens, who may or may not be members of the City Council, selected by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia. The terms of the citizen members shall be two years or until successors are appointed. The board shall select its own chairman. Five members present at a meeting shall constitute a quorum. Meetings shall be held at the call of the chairman but shall be held no less frequently than once a month in any event. The plumbing board members shall serve without pay."

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in The Alexandria Gazette.
