

ORDINANCE NO. 358

AN ORDINANCE to repeal and re-enact Ordinance No. 330.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 330 entitled "An ordinance to amend Section 3, Chapter 28 of the City Code of Alexandria, Virginia" be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

"Section 1. That the 'Revised Zoning Map' described and referred to in Section 3 of Chapter 28 of the Alexandria City Code, enacted as a whole on the 2nd day of July, 1940 and effective August 5, 1940, be and the same is hereby amended in the following particulars so that the pieces of property hereinafter listed are changed to the respective zones specified:

(a) A strip of land 300 feet in depth running north from Slater's lane and fronting on the west-erly side of the Mount Vernon Memorial Highway for a distance of 1600 feet, said property belong-ing to the Richmond, Fredericksburg & Potomac Railroad Company, to C-2 Residence Zone.

(b) Property belonging to Joseph K. Seidle, Inc. and constituting the west side of St. Asaph Street between Green and Church streets and the east side of Washington Street between Green and Church Streets from A Residence Zone to C-2 Residence Zone.

(c) Property belonging to George Webster known as 509 North Patrick Street from C-1 Residence Zone to D-2 Commercial Zone.

(d) Property known as 401 East Braddock Road, being at the southeast intersection of Braddock Road and Mount Vernon Avenue from B Residence Zone to D-2 Commercial Zone.

(e) Property belonging to Elsie C. Bunt lying at the northwest corner of Duke and Peyton Streets to D-2 Commercial Zone.

(f) All that property running south from Frank-lin Street for a distance of 125 feet for the full depth of the block between Washington Street and St. Asaph Street to D-2 Commercial Zone."

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in The Alexandria Gazette.
