

ORDINANCE No. 359

AN ORDINANCE to vacate and close as public streets a portion of South Pitt Street and a portion of Church Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, it is desirable from the view point of the public and of the owners of property adjoining the streets hereinafter described to vacate, close and abandon the same as hereinafter set forth; therefore, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That all of South Pitt Street lying between the southerly line of Green Street and the northerly line of Church Street be and the same is hereby vacated, closed and abandoned as a public thoroughfare.

Section 2. That all of Church Street west of the easterly line of Pitt Street extended and east of the easterly line of an alley running north and south midway through the square of ground bounded on the west by South St. Asaph Street and on the east by South Pitt Street, be and the same is hereby vacated, closed and abandoned as a public thoroughfare.

Section 3. That this ordinance be recorded among the land records of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, appropriately indexed in the name of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia and the streets affected hereby.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in The Alexandria Gazette.
