

ORDINANCE No. 360

AN ORDINANCE to punish nuisances.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That Chapter XXXI of the Alexandria City Code, enacted as a whole on the 2nd day of July, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same is hereby amended by the addition of the following section to be inserted between Sec. 27 and Sec. 28 thereof:

"Sec. 27a. It shall be unlawful for any person, whether owner or tenant, to keep or permit, either upon unimproved or improved real estate, within the city any thing or number of things which are dangerous, offensive or unhealthy so as to cause injury or annoyance to citizens of the city. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall for each offense be liable to a fine of not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00)."

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in The Alexandria Gazette.
