

## ORDINANCE No. 361

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 3, Chapter XXVIII of the City Code of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That the "Revised Zoning Map" described and referred to be and the same is hereby amended so that the following described piece of property is hereby changed from A Residence Zone to D-2 Commercial Zone:

All that part of the property now in the name of Anthony Ciuffreda and wife, being bounded and described more particularly as—

Beginning at an iron pipe in the west property line of Mount Vernon Avenue, said pipe being S 13° 06' E 300.0 feet from an original iron pipe on the west side of Mount Vernon Avenue at Four Mile Run (said original iron pipe being the northeast corner of the former A. Schlevogt ownership); thence with the west property line of Mount Vernon Avenue S 13° 06' E 147.96 feet to an iron pipe; thence N 79° 41' 20" W 125.0 feet to an iron pipe; thence parallel to the west line of Mount Vernon Avenue N 13° 06' W 147.96 feet to an iron pipe; thence S 79° 41' 20" E 125.0 feet to an iron pipe in the west property line of Mount Vernon Avenue and place of beginning and containing 16,972 square feet.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in The Alexandria Gazette.
