

# ORDINANCE NO. 369

AN ORDINANCE to amend chapter 7 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 2nd, 1940, being the chapter relating to the imposition of license taxes on various businesses, professions and occupations, by repealing and re-enacting Section 7 (i) which relates to parking lots; adding Section 7 (k) which relates to Camp Sites and Trailer Camps, and by repealing and re-enacting Section 24 relating to contractors.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, that Chapter 7 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be amended by repealing and re-enacting section 7 (i); Adding section 7 (k) and by repealing and re-enacting section 24, to read as follows:

Chapter 7, section 7 (i). **Automobiles, storage.** Persons operating lots for storage or parking of automobiles, busses, automobile trucks, for hire, shall pay an annual license, if from one to 20 unit capacity, of \$25.00, and if more than twenty unit capacity, of \$50.00.

Section 7 (k). **Camp sites and trailer parks.** Persons, firms or corporations operating camp sites or trailer parks, duly approved pursuant to other regulations of the City of Alexandria, shall pay an annual license tax on each camp or trailer area on the site or park, as defined by the regulations of the City of Alexandria governing the establishment and operation of camp sites and trailer camps, of \$4.00.

Section 24. **Contractors.** Any person accepting orders or contracts for any work on or in any building or structure, requiring the use of paint, wallpaper, stone, brick mortar, wood, cement, structural iron or steel, sheet iron, galvanized iron, metallic piping, tin, lead, electric wiring, or other metal, or any other material, or who shall accept contracts or orders for the construction, installation, or repair of any type of heating plant or equipment, plumbing or electrical installation, in any building or structure, or who shall accept contracts to do any paving, or curbing on sidewalks or streets, public or private property, using asphalt, brick, stone, cement, wood or any composition, or shall accept an order for or contract to excavate earth, rock, or other material for foundations or any other purpose or who shall accept an order or contract to construct any sewer of stone, brick, terra cotta, or other material shall be deemed a contractor. The annual license tax for a contract or order shall be \$25.00 for the first \$5,000.00 gross business, and \$50.00 if the gross business exceeds \$5,000.00 and not over \$10,000.00 for the preceding calendar year; \$100.00 if gross business is in excess of \$10,000.00 and not over \$50,000.00 for the preceding calendar year; \$150.00 if gross business is in excess of \$50,000.00 and not over \$100,000.00 for the preceding calendar year; \$200.00 if gross business is in excess of \$100,000 and not over \$250,000; \$500.00 if the gross business is over \$250,000.00; provided, however, that in no case shall the license tax be less than \$25.00, and provided further that any license issued hereunder to a contractor for any order or contract hereinbefore set forth, who may subcontract any part of his said order or contract, shall not be in lieu of the license to be paid by a contractor who may accept such contract. Where the person, firm or corporation has not obtained a license for or done business in the City during the preceding year the amount to be paid shall be estimated and an adjustment made according to the actual amount involved at the end of the year.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect on the day following its publication in The Alexandria Gazette.
