

# ORDINANCE NO. 379

AN ORDINANCE to vacate two portions of Church Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is to the best interest of the City of Alexandria to vacate and abandon the following described portions of the following named street so that public purposes paramount to the use of said street may be served; now therefore

Section 1. That the following portions of Church Street be and the same hereby are vacated and abandoned as public streets or thoroughfares:

(a) That portion lying between the projected west line of the alley between Washington and St. Asaph Streets and the west line of St. Asaph Street;

(b) That portion consisting of a strip three feet wide bordering St. Mary's Cemetery and running from the above west line of St. Asaph Street eastwardly 197 feet to the projected east line of the alley between St. Asaph and Pitt Streets.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
