

## ORDINANCE NO. 392

**AN ORDINANCE to vacate a portion of Fayette Alley in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.**

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council that it serves the best interests of the City of Alexandria to vacate and abandon the following described portion of the following named alley, upon the request of the Navy Department of the United States, so that public purposes paramount to the use of said alley may be served: now therefore

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia as follows:

Section 1. That that portion of Fayette Alley lying between the easterly side of Union Street and the Potomac River, all in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned insofar as the right, title, estate and interest of the City of Alexandria in said alley is concerned provided, however, that the said Navy Department or the United States of America through such other Department or Bureau as may be by it designated, shall provide for the appropriate relocation of any public works of the City now located in or under the surface of said alley.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
