

ORDINANCE NO. 399

AN ORDINANCE to repeal and re-enact Section 25 of Chapter 26 of the Alexandria City Code.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VA.:

Section 1. That Section 25 of Chapter 26 of the Alexandria City Code enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same hereby is repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

"Sec. 25. To follow regulations of Board of Fire Underwriters and rules of electrical board and council.

(a) All electric work shall be done in the manner prescribed by the current edition of the regulations of the National Board of Fire Underwriters, known as the "National Electrical Code", together with supplementary rules and regulations as may be issued from time to time by the electrical board, and approved by the Council, copies of which supplementary rules shall be furnished all registered electricians by the electrical inspector, but any supplementary regulations shall be effective 30 days after approval by the Council.

(b) No person, firm or corporation shall offer for sale any device for the over-current protection of electrical services or circuits without first securing a certificate as to his knowledge of requirements for said device from the Office of the Electrical Inspector. The fee for said certificate is to be \$1.00 per year. This certificate is to be posted at or near the location where such device is sold. This does not apply to any person or firm holding a Master Electrician's Certificate in the City.

(c) On or after February 1, 1943, it shall be unlawful for any person or firm to offer for sale to the public in the City of Alexandria any electrical wiring supplies, fixtures, appliances, or any equipment which operates electrically that do not meet the approval of the National Board of Fire Underwriters.

(d) It shall be the duty of the Electrical Inspector at frequent intervals to inspect all electrical supplies, fixtures, or appliances offered for sale in the City and to cause the removal of same which do not meet requirements."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
