

## ORDINANCE NO. 406

**AN ORDINANCE closing parts of St. Asaph and Third Streets and certain alleys.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the following streets and alleys be and the same hereby are vacated as public streets and ways, and thoroughfares:

1. All that part of St. Asaph Street running from the north side of First Street to the south side of Second Street.

2. All that part of St. Asaph Street running from the north side of Second Street to the Lockarbor Gardens property.

3. All that part of Third Street running from the west side of Royal Street to the east side of Pitt Street and from the west side of Pitt Street to the right of way of the George Washington Memorial Boulevard.

4. All those alleys existing in the squares of ground bounded by Royal, St. Asaph, First, and Third Streets.

This ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
