

# ORDINANCE NO. 410

AN ORDINANCE to close part of an unnamed street in Alexandria, being the fourth street north of Montgomery Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

WHEREAS, it has become advisable for the benefit of the public welfare to close that part of the street hereinafter described; and whereas, proper notice and publication of application for said closing have been had, viewers have been appointed and have reported favorably upon the closing; and whereas, the Planning Commission of the City of Alexandria has recommended the same; now therefore

Section 1. That unnamed street located within the City of Alexandria, and being known as the fourth street north of Montgomery Street and running parallel to and approximately fifteen feet from Bashford Road, be and the same hereby is vacated as a public street from the west line of Pitt Street to the east line of Mount Vernon Memorial Highway.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
