

# ORDINANCE NO. 411

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 3, Chapter 28 of the City Code of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted July 2, 1940.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That the "Revised Zoning Map" described and referred to in Section 3 of Chapter 28 of the Alexandria City Code, enacted as a whole on the 2nd day of July, 1940 and effective August 5, 1940, be and the same is hereby amended in the following particulars so that the pieces of property hereinafter listed are changed to the respective zones specified:

- (a) 115-117 North Alfred Street to C-2 Residence Zone;
- (b) 108 East Alexandria Avenue to B Residence Zone;
- (c) Rear portion of 212-214 North Washington Street to B Residence Zone;
- (d) 322 South Washington Street from A Residence Zone to C-2 Residence Zone;
- (e) Tract of land containing approximately 9/10ths of an acre, bounded on the north by Slater's Lane, on the northeast by the right of way of the W. and O. D. Railroad, and on the south by the tract of land belonging to Allwine, known as the William L. Travers' Tract, to C-2 Residence Zone;
- (f) The following described property to E Industrial Zone:  
Beginning at a point 197.50 feet west of the west line of the Alexandria-Washington Turnpike and 270 feet north of the north line of Reed Avenue; thence proceeding west parallel with Reed Avenue 100 feet; thence north parallel with the Alexandria-Washington Turnpike 115 feet; thence east parallel with Reed Avenue 100 feet; thence south parallel with Alexandria-Washington Turnpike 115 feet to the beginning.
- (g) 228 North Fairfax Street from C-2 Residence Zone to D-2 Commercial Zone;
- (h) 200 South Pitt Street to C-2 Residence Zone;
- (i) 401 Prince Street to C-2 Residence Zone.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
