

## Ordinance No. 425

AN ORDINANCE to repeal and to re-enact an ordinance passed June 22, 1943, providing for two polling places in the sixth ward of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That in all elections hereafter held in the City of Alexandria, Virginia there shall be two polling places in the sixth ward of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 2. That the dividing line in the sixth ward shall be the center line of Russell Road from its intersection with Bellefonte Avenue running northerly to its intersection with Glebe Road, and the center line of Glebe Road from its intersection with Russell Road running northwesterly to the Alexandria City limits; and that the polling place for all sixth ward voters residing west or southwest of the said dividing line shall be the George Mason School; and that the polling place for all sixth ward voters residing east or northeast of said dividing line shall be the Mt. Vernon School Annex located on Mt. Vernon Avenue.

Section 3. That an ordinance passed June 22, 1943, providing for two polling places in the sixth ward of the City of Alexandria, Virginia be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage, but the same shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette for the information of the people.
