

ORDINANCE 433

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 3, Chapter 28, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, relating to location and boundaries of zones.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the "Revised Zoning Map" described and referred to in Section 3, of Chapter 28, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same is hereby amended in the particulars following so that the pieces of property hereinafter listed are changed to the respective zones specified:

- (1) A parcel of land described on City Assessment Map 128, Block 2, as Lot 6, and also known as No. 814 Duke Street, to D-2 commercial.
- (2) A parcel of land described on City Assessment Map 214, Block 1, as Lots 6, 6A, 7, 8, and 9, located on the east side of Mt. Vernon Avenue, to D-2 commercial.
- (3) All of that land beginning at a point on the West side of Henry Street, 105'8" north of Wythe Street; and running North on Henry Street 17'6"; and thence West parallel to Wythe Street 83'5" to a ten foot alley; thence South, parallel to Henry Street 17'6"; and thence East parallel to Wythe Street 83'5" to the point of beginning. Lot 14-B Blk 5 Map 123 and known as 710 North Henry Street from C-Residential to D-Industrial.
- (4) A tract of land containing approximately 12 $\frac{3}{4}$ acres, located on the West side of U. S. Highway No. 1, with a frontage of 861' thereon and being bordered on the South by property of Fannon, on the West by right-of-way of W. & O. D. Railroad and others and the North line of said tract being generally approximately 160' South of the South line of Section 1 of the subdivision of St. Elmo from D-2 and A to E-Industrial.

Section 9. That this ordinance shall become effective immediately after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
