

## ORDINANCE 437

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Sec. 3, Chapter 7, of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 5, 1940, relating to license taxes on agents.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Sec. 3, Chapter 7 of The Code of The City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same is hereby amended and reordained so as to read as follows:

### Sec. 3 Agents.

(a) Book agents.—Book agents selling directly to customers shall pay an annual license tax of \$50.00.

(b) Collecting agents.—Persons doing business as collecting agents or agencies shall pay an annual license tax of \$50.00. The provisions of this subdivision shall not apply to attorneys-at-law.

(c) Labor agents.—Labor agents, as defined by the laws of this state shall pay an annual license tax of \$500.00.

(d) Lightning rod agents.—Lightning rod agents putting up work in the city shall pay an annual license tax of \$25.00.

(e) Mercantile agents.—Mercantile agencies, as defined by the law of this state shall pay an annual license tax of \$25.00.

(f) Real estate agents.—Real estate agents or brokers shall pay an annual license tax of one-tenth of one percent on all sales made during the preceding calendar year, but in no case shall the annual license tax be less than \$50.00.

(g) Rental agents.—For the privilege of renting real estate an agent shall pay an annual license tax of \$20.00. The provisions of this subdivision shall not apply to real estate-agents or brokers.

(h) Soliciting agents.—Persons, firms and corporations doing business as solicitors, and not otherwise in this section taxed, shall pay an annual license tax of \$50.00 and one-tenth of one percent of gross earnings, receipts, fees or commissions for the preceding calendar year in excess of \$1,000.00. Notice of intention to engage in business of solicitor shall be filed with the Chief of Police before a license will be issued.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective on the day after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
