

ORDINANCE No. 453

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 40, Article 2, Chapter 11 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 5, 1940, as amended by Ordinance No. 348, relating to parking meter zones.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 40, of Article 2, Chapter 11, of the Code of The City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 5, 1940, as amended by Ordinance No. 348, be and the same hereby is repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Sec. 40. Parking Meter Zones Established.

The following described parts of the streets in the City of Alexandria are hereby established as parking meter zones:

(a) Both sides of King Street from Union Street to Commonwealth Avenue.

(b) Both sides of the 100 block north and the 100 block south of each street intersecting with King Street from Fairfax Street to West Street, both inclusive.

(c) Both sides of Prince Street between St. Asaph Street and Columbus Street.

(d) Both sides of Cameron Street between Royal Street and Pitt Street; also the north side of Cameron Street between Pitt Street and St. Asaph Street.

(e) Both sides of Market Alley between Fairfax Street and Royal Street.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective the day after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
