

Ordinance No. 454

AN ORDINANCE to repeal and reordain Section 156, Chapter XIII, of the Building Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia being an ordinance adopted May 23, 1939, relating to baseball stands and all other forms of outdoor places of amusement.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 156, Chapter XIII, of the Building Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, being an ordinance adopted May 23, 1939, be and the same hereby is repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 156-Baseball Stands.

Baseball stands and all other forms of outdoor places of amusement shall conform to all the requirements of this code for public halls as to aisles, stairways, arrangement of seats, and all the construction of such stands shall be subject to the requirements of the Code except that outdoor bleacher type seats without backs may be spaced twenty-four (24) inches apart.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective the day after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
