

Ordinance No. 458

AN ORDINANCE to repeal and re-enact Section 3, Chapter 31, of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 5, 1940, relating to assault and assault and battery.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 3, Chapter 31, of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same hereby is repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Sec. 3. Assaults and Assault and battery.

(a) Any person who shall assault another person, without legal excuse or justification, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 or more than \$100.00, or by confinement in the city jail for a period of not more than 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

(b) Any person who shall commit assault and battery against another person, without legal excuse or justification, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 or more than \$300.00, or by confinement in the city jail for a period not to exceed 3 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective the day after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
