

Ordinance 466

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 3, Chapter 28, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, relating to location and boundaries of zones.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the "Second Revised Zoning Map" described and referred to in Section 3, as amended, of Chapter 28, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same is hereby amended in the particulars following so that the pieces of property hereinafter listed are changed to the respective zones specified:

- (1) Lot 7, Block 18, Assessment Map 210, located at the northeast corner of Luray and Hancock Avenues, having a frontage of 188 feet on Luray Avenue and 130 feet on Hancock Avenue, also known as 3, 5, 7 and 9 West Luray Avenue, to C-2 Residential.
- (2) Lot 1, Block 1, Map 108, located on the south side of Duke Street 615.67 feet west of West Street, having a width on the front of the lot of 106.19 feet and a width along the right-of-way of Southern Railroad Company of 169.98 feet and a depth of 287.75 feet, to D-2 Commercial.
- (3) 222 North St. Asaph Street, known as Lot 88, Block 1, Assessment Map 138, located on the west side of St. Asaph Street 92.75 feet south of Queen Street, having a frontage of 30.75 feet and a depth of 121 feet, to C-2 Residential.
- (4) Lot 1, Block 3, Assessment Map 215, located at the southwest corner of Glebe Road and Mt. Vernon Avenue, having a frontage of 40 feet 5 inches on Glebe Road and 33.51 feet on Mt. Vernon Avenue, to D-2 Commercial.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
