

Ordinance 467

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 40, Article 2, Chapter 11 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, as amended, relating to parking meter zones.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 40, of Article 2, Chapter 11, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, as amended by Ordinance No. 461, be and the same hereby is amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 40. Parking Meter Zones Established.

The following described parts of the streets of the City of Alexandria are hereby established as parking meter zones:

(a) Both sides of King Street from Union Street to Commonwealth Avenue.

(b) Both sides of the 100 block north and the 100 block south of each street intersecting with King Street from Fairfax Street to West Street, both inclusive.

(c) Both sides of Cameron Street between Royal Street and Pitt Street; also the north side of Cameron Street between Pitt Street and St. Asaph Street.

(d) Both sides of Prince Street between St. Asaph Street and Washington Street.

(e) Both sides of Market Alley between Fairfax Street and Royal Street.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective the day after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
