

Ordinance No. 483

AN ORDINANCE to vacate a portion of Bayliss Drive, one of the public streets of the City of Alexandria.

Whereas, it has been determined by the City Council that it will be for the best interests of the city to abandon and vacate as a public street a small portion of Bayliss Drive in order to facilitate the realignment of said street, and since sufficient additional land is being obtained in the process,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That all that portion of Bayliss Drive, one of the public streets of the city, said portion being described as beginning at the east corner of Lot 30, Overlook Terrace Subdivision, as the same is duly recorded among the land records of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and running thence with the arc of a curve to the left whose radius is 360.00 feet and whose chord and chord bearing are 59.56 feet and S 41°04'16" E, respectively, a distance of 59.63 feet; thence S 19°04'48" W 9.71 feet; thence with the arc of a curve to the left whose radius is 219.80 feet and whose chord and chord bearing are 36.70 feet and N 31°34'12" W, respectively, a distance of 36.70 feet; and thence N 36°20'34" W 28.30 feet to the point of beginning, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned as a public street and thoroughfare.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage.
