

City Ordinance No. 508

AN ORDINANCE changing the voting place in the third ward of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and repealing all prior ordinances and resolutions inconsistent therewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That the voting place in the third ward of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, located on the east side of the one hundred block North Patrick Street in the building formerly known as No. 5 Fire House, now being converted for use as a juvenile and domestic relations court, be and the same hereby is changed to the new building of the No. 5 Fire House located on the south side of the twelve hundred block of Cameron Street in said third ward.

Section 2. That all ordinances and resolutions heretofore adopted with relation to the establishment of a voting place in the third ward of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and inconsistent with the provisions hereof, be and the same hereby are repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage, but the same shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette for the information of the citizens of said city.
