

Ordinance No. 518

AN ORDINANCE making provision for the support of the City government, the payment of interest and principal of the City debt, and for other municipal expenses and purposes; and appropriating to the several funds the several amounts required to defray the expenditures and liabilities of the municipal corporation for the calendar year 1948.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, does hereby make provision for and appropriates to the several funds hereinafter named, the several amounts required to defray the expenditures and liabilities of the municipal corporation for the calendar year 1948 payable from the several general funds and from any other fund created by law as follows:

(A) General and School Fund—	
1. For defraying the general expenses of the Corporation the sum of	\$ 2,095,169.51
2. For defraying the general expenses of the public schools, the sum of	846,974.11
(B) For the payment of the public debt of the corporation and the interest thereon, the sum of	285,605.38
GRAND TOTAL	\$ 3,227,749.00

Section 2. That it is further ordered that the necessary moneys required to finance the various departments of the City may be raised by one or more temporary loans in anticipation of the collection of taxes; provided, however, that any and all loans made as herein authorized together with the interest thereon, shall be paid out of the sum to be raised by taxes to be levied as by law provided.

Section 3. That it is further ordered that the allotment of money appropriated in Section 1 in this ordinance to the several municipal departments and their functional divisions, for the calendar year 1948 shall be as follows:
