

Ordinance No. 523

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Sec. 7, Chapter 26, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, which chapter relates generally to electricity and which section relates to the composition, terms and pay of the Electrical Board.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That Sec. 7, of Chapter 26, of the Code of the city of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 7. Composition, terms and pay of Board.

The Electrical Board shall consist of five persons; the electrical inspector, by virtue of his office, appointed by the city manager, and two master electricians, one journeyman electrician and one qualified electrical engineer employed by the local electric utility company, appointed by the council for a term of four years, except that the terms of the members of the Board beginning in 1948 shall expire as follows: The first term of one of the two master electricians shall end on the fourth December 31 following date of appointment; the first term of the journeyman electrician shall end on the third December 31 following date of appointment; the first term of the electrical engineer shall end on the second December 31 following appointment and the first term of the other master electrician shall end on the first December 31 following date of appointment. Thereafter the term of each member of the Board shall be for a term of four years as aforesaid, except the Electrical Inspector whose term shall be co-extensive with the time he holds office as such. The members of the Board shall serve without pay, but the Council may authorize any expense that it deems proper.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette and it shall become effective the day after its publication.
