

Ordinance No. 540

AN ORDINANCE adopting and enforcing daylight saving time in the City of Alexandria, Virginia for the period beginning at 2:00 o'clock A.M., E.S.T., May 2, 1948, and ending at 2:00 o'clock A.M., E.S.T., September 6, 1948.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of Virginia, in Chapter 115, Acts of 1948, having granted the authority and the Governor of Virginia having first given his approval in writing as required by law;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That daylight saving time be and the same hereby is adopted as the official time in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and all the area within the corporate limits thereof, for the period beginning at 2:00 o'clock A.M., E.S.T., May 2, 1948, and ending at 2:00 o'clock A.M., E.S.T., September 6, 1948, and all clocks in the City shall be advanced one hour at the beginning of said period and they shall be set back one hour at the end of said period.

Section 2. That the daylight saving time herein so prescribed for the period beginning at 2:00 o'clock A.M., E.S.T., May 2, 1948, and ending at 2 o'clock A.M., E.S.T., September 6, 1948, shall govern the conduct of all businesses and elections in the City of Alexandria, Virginia during that time.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall become effective from the time of its passage, and shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette for the information of the citizens of the City.
