

# Ordinance No. 551

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940 by adding a chapter thereto designated Chapter XI-A regulating parking on City owned property, repealing conflicting law, and imposing penalties.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That the code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a chapter designated as Chapter XI-A following Chapter XI to read as follows:

## CHAPTER XI-A

### Parking on City Owned Property

Sec. 1 South portion of market court reserved for public officials, etc. public parking prohibited during certain days; inconsistent provisions repealed.

The area of land owned by the City and lying in the market court between the City Hall Building on the north and the south line of the City Hall Building excluding the City market shed. The depth of this area is 105' 9" from the south line of market alley extended, is hereby reserved for the exclusive use in parking by public officials and employees on Mondays through Fridays, both inclusive, of each week; and parking on such land by any person other than public officials and employees during such time is hereby prohibited. Such provisions of Sec. 40, as amended, Chapter 11, of this code as are in conflict with this section are hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. City Manager to assign parking spaces.

The city manager is hereby authorized and empowered to lay off the land reserved in Sec. 1 of this chapter and assign parking spaces therein to as many and such public officials and employees as in his judgment will best serve the public interest. No public official or employee other than an assignee to whom space is so assigned shall thereafter park on said land during Mondays through Fridays, both inclusive, of each week.

Sec. 3. Penalties.

Any person violating the provisions of this chapter shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette and it shall become effective the day after its publication.
