

Ordinance No. 555

AN ORDINANCE adopting and enforcing daylight saving time in the City of Alexandria, Virginia for the period beginning at 2:00 o'clock a.m., E.S.T., September 17, 1948 and ending at 2:00 a.m., E.S.T., September 26, 1948.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of Virginia, in Chapter 115, Acts of 1948, having granted the authority and the Governor of Virginia having first given his approval in writing as required by said Act;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That daylight saving time be and the same hereby is adopted as the official time in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and all the area within the corporate limits thereof, for the period beginning at 2:00 o'clock a.m., E.S.T., September 17, 1948, and ending at 2:00 o'clock a.m., E.S.T., September 26, 1948, and all clocks in the City shall be advanced one hour at the beginning of said period and they shall be set back one hour at the end of said period.

Section 2. That the daylight saving time herein so prescribed for the period beginning at 2:00 o'clock a.m., E.S.T., September 17, 1948, and ending at 2 o'clock a.m., E.S.T., September 26, 1948, shall govern the conduct of all businesses and elections in the City of Alexandria, Virginia during that time.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette and it shall become effective immediately after its publication.
