

## Ordinance No. 556

AN ORDINANCE TO amend and re-ordain Section 34, Article 16, Chapter 28, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, as said section appears in an amendment to said Chapter 28 adopted August 13, 1946, designated as Ordinance No. 470, said Chapter 28 relating generally to zoning and said Section 34 relating specifically to the creation and composition of the Board of Architectural Review.

WHEREAS, pursuant to due and timely notice of the time and place of hearing published in a paper of general circulation in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, a public hearing was held in relation to the changes hereinafter made, at which public hearing parties in interest and citizens had an opportunity to be heard,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That Section 34, Article 16, Chapter 28, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 5, 1940, as said section appears in an amendment to said Chapter 28 adopted August 13, 1946, designated as Ordinance No. 470, be and the same hereby is amended and re-ordained to read as follows:

### Sec. 34. Board of Architectural Review.

For the purpose of making effective the provisions of this article there is hereby created a board to be known as the "Board of Architectural Review," to be composed of seven members who are citizens of the City of Alexandria, six of whom shall be appointed by the City Council. Two members shall be certified architects; one a member of the City Council; one an established, licensed real estate broker in the City; and two persons with knowledge of and demonstrated interest in the historical character of the old part of the city. The building inspector shall be a member by virtue of his office. The term of office of the members shall be three years, except that the term of the building inspector shall correspond to his official tenure of office. Any appointed member of the board may be removed from office by the Council after public hearing for inefficiency, neglect of duty, or malfeasance. An appointment to fill a vacancy shall be only for the unexpired portion of the term.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette, and it shall become effective the day after its publication.
