

Ordinance No. 561

AN ORDINANCE authorizing encroachment in and upon Prince Street in accordance with Section 3015a of the Code of Virginia.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA that:

Whereas Kemper Simpson, unmarried, is the owner of the two-story brick building on premises known as 1117 Prince Street in the City of Alexandria, which said building on January 1st, 1948 did encroach in and upon a public street in said City known as Prince Street, by a width of 27.33 feet to a distance of approximately one foot and has applied for appropriate relief in order to be able to enjoy and convey good title to said premises:

Now therefore: that the owner of premises at 1117 Prince Street, Alexandria, Virginia and his successors and assigns in title are hereby authorized to maintain the said encroachment of the building at 1117 Prince Street in and upon a certain public street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia known as Prince Street, as said encroachment existed on January 1st, 1948, provided said encroachment does not extend more than approximately one foot in and upon said street, and provided further that said encroachment and all rights and privileges conferred by this ordinance shall cease and determine immediately upon the removal or destruction of the said structure.
