

Ordinance No. 564

AN ORDINANCE to amend and re-enact Sections 35 and 56, Chapter VII of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, as said Chapter VII is amended by Ordinance No. 521 adopted January 31, 1948, and to amend said Chapter VII, as amended, by adding a new section numbered 61-A, which said Chapter VII, as amended, all relates to annual city license taxes, regulations and penalties.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That Section 35, Chapter VII of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, as said Chapter VII is amended by Ordinance No. 521 adopted January 31, 1948, be and the same hereby is amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 35. Carnivals, Festivals, Fiestas, etc.

Carnivals, festivals, fiestas and amusements of like nature, for the privilege of doing business in the city shall pay a license tax of \$1,000.00 per day, or \$6,000.00 per week; and no rebate shall be allowed for rainy days, and no waiver of this tax shall be made or passed for any reason. Carnivals, festivals, fiestas and amusements of like nature using the streets of the city for parades or other forms of publicity when not located within the corporate limits shall pay for the said privilege a license tax in the same amount they are hereby required to pay if located within the city. A permit from the city manager shall first be obtained before any license is issued hereunder which involves use of the streets of the city for parades; and the chief of police shall be immediately notified in writing when any such permit and license is issued.

Section 2. That Section 56, Chapter VII of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, as said Chapter VII is amended by Ordinance No. 521 adopted January 31, 1948, be and the same hereby is amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 56. Sound Trucks.

Persons or corporations using loud speakers or amplifiers on automobile trucks or other vehicles on the streets of the city for commercial purposes or for advertising shall pay for the privilege a license tax of \$25.00 per day for each vehicle.

Section 3. That Chapter VII of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 5, 1940, as said Chapter VII is amended by Ordinance No. 521 adopted January 31, 1948, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new section numbered 61-A following Section 61, which new section reads as follows:

Sec. 61-A. Regulatory Tax on certain other businesses, etc.

Every person required by the provisions of Sections 61, 62, 63, 64, 65, 66, 67, 69, 72, 73 and 75 of this chapter to pay the respective license taxes therein designated, and all manufacturers, millers and processors doing business in the city, shall pay for the privilege of doing business an annual regulatory license tax of \$25.00 in addition to non-regulatory license taxes.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette and it shall become effective the day after its publication.
