

## Ordinance No. 567

**AN ORDINANCE authorizing encroachment in and upon Wolfe Street in accordance with Section 3015a of the Code of Virginia.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, THAT:**

Whereas A. Campbell Turner, widower, is the owner of the frame building and fence on premises known as 330 South Lee Street, and located at the northeast intersection of Lee and Wolfe Streets, in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, which said building and fence on January 1, 1948, did encroach in and upon a public street in said city known as Wolfe Street, by a width of 50 feet to a distance of approximately 1.39 feet, and has applied for appropriate relief in order to be able to enjoy and convey good title to said premises;

Now, therefore, the owner of premises at 330 South Lee Street, Alexandria, Virginia, and his successors and assigns in title are hereby authorized to maintain the said encroachment of the building and fence at 330 South Lee Street in and upon a certain public street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, known as Wolfe Street, as said encroachment existed on January 1, 1948, provided said encroachment does not extend more than approximately 1.39 feet in and upon said street for a width of approximately 50 feet, and provided further that said encroachment and all rights and privileges conferred by this ordinance shall cease and determine immediately upon the removal or destruction of the said structures.

That this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage.
