

Ordinance No. 575

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the owner and his successors in title to maintain encroachment of building on premises No. 606 Princess Street, as of January 1, 1948, in, upon and over one of the public streets of the city, until such building is destroyed or removed.

Whereas, Joseph Lawrence is the owner of a certain lot of ground located on the south side of Princess Street 123.5 feet more or less east of Washington Street, in the City of Alexandria, extending for its width eastwardly 22 feet, together with the improvements thereon known as premises 606 Princess Street; and

Whereas, the building thereon, being 22 feet wide and covering the full width of said lot, does and did on January 1, 1948 and for many years prior thereto encroach in, upon and over said Princess Street, one of the public streets of the city, to the extent and distance of 2.42 feet; and

Whereas, it is determined that the continuance of said encroachment until such building is destroyed or removed will not be detrimental to the public interest;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA:

That the said Joseph Lawrence, and his successors in title, be and they hereby are authorized to maintain and continue such encroachment on the public street as it existed on January 1, 1948 until such building is destroyed or removed; provided this authority shall not be construed to relieve said owners of any negligence on their part on account of such encroachment.
