

Ordinance No. 580

AN ORDINANCE adopting and enforcing daylight saving time in the City of Alexandria, Virginia for the period beginning at 2 o'clock A. M., E.S.T., April 24, 1949, and ending at 2 o'clock A. M., E.S.T., September 25, 1949.

Whereas, the General Assembly of Virginia, Chapter 115, Acts of 1948, having granted the authority and the Governor of Virginia having first given his approval in writing as required by said Act:

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That daylight saving time be and the same hereby is adopted as the official time in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, in all the area within the corporate limits thereof, for the period beginning at 2 o'clock A. M., E.S.T., April 24, 1949, and ending at 2 o'clock A. M., E.S.T., September 25, 1949 and all clocks in the City shall be advanced one hour at the beginning of said period and they shall be set back one hour at the end of said period.

Section 2. That daylight saving time provided for in Section 1 hereof for the period beginning at 2 o'clock A. M., E.S.T., April 24, 1949, and ending at 2 o'clock A. M., E.S.T., September 25, 1949, shall govern the conduct of all businesses and elections in the City of Alexandria, Virginia during that time and period.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect from and after the time of its passage, and it shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette for the information of the citizens of the city. The clerk shall note the time of publication upon the minutes of this Council.
