

Ordinance No. 591

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 40 and Section 41, as amended, Chapter 11, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, which said sections relate to the establishment of parking meter zones and the time limits for parking in parking meter spaces, respectively.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

1. That Section 40, as amended, Chapter 11 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same here be is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 40. Parking Meter Zones Established.

The following described parts of the City of Alexandria are hereby established as parking meter zones:

- (a) Both sides of King Street from Union Street to Commonwealth Avenue.
- (b) Both sides of the 100 block north and the 100 block south of each street intersecting with King Street from Fairfax Street to West Street, both, inclusive.
- (c) Both sides of Cameron Street between Fairfax Street and Pitt Street; also the north side of Cameron Street between Pitt Street and St. Asaph Street.
- (d) Both sides of Prince Street between St. Asaph Street and Columbus Street.
- (e) Both sides of the 200 block South Washington Street.

2. That Section 41, as amended, Chapter 11 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same here be is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 41. Time Limits.

The time limits for parking in any space in said parking meter zones shall be determined by deposit of coin or coins in each parking meter as follows, provided that the time limit for parking shall in no case exceed two hours:

- 12 minutes for one cent (1c)
- 24 minutes for two cents (2c)
- 36 minutes for three cents (3c)
- 48 minutes for four cents (4c)
- 60 minutes for five cents (5c)
- 120 minutes for ten cents (10c)

The hours of the day or night during which the parking meter restrictions shall be in force shall be determined by the traffic board of the City of Alexandria, provided that no charge or charges shall be made for parking on Sundays and legal holidays.

3. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette, and it shall become effective on the day after its publication. The clerk shall note the time of such publication in the minutes.
