

Ordinance No. 602

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 13, Chapter 3, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, as said Chapter 3 is amended by Ordinance No. 589 adopted July 12, 1949, which said Chapter relates generally to the Council, and which said Section relates specifically to order of business of the Council.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That Section 13, Chapter 3, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, as said Chapter 3 is amended by Ordinance No. 589, adopted July 12, 1949, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 13. Order of business.

At every regular meeting of the Council the order of business shall be as follows:

1. Invocation.
2. Calling the roll.
3. Reading and acting upon the minutes of the previous meeting. If the clerk of the Council, at least two days before the meeting, shall transmit to each member of Council at his business or residence address a copy of the minutes of such previous meeting for inspection, reading thereof before the Council assembled may on motion be dispensed with and such minutes so inspected may be acted upon.
4. Consideration of and action upon the docket.
5. Reports of committees.
6. Offering of ordinances, resolutions and petitions; and other new business.

The order of business shall not be departed from except by the consent of four members of the Council.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect the day after its passage.
