

Ordinance No. 615

AN ORDINANCE to amend and re-enact Section 67, Chapter VII of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, as said Chapter VII is amended by Ordinance No. 521 adopted January 31, 1948 and Ordinance No. 564 adopted December 30, 1948, which said Chapter VII, as amended, relates to annual city license Taxes, regulations and penalties, and which said section relates to contractors and contracting.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

1. That Section 67, Chapter VII of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, as said chapter is amended by Ordinance No. 521 adopted January 31, 1948 and Ordinance No. 564 adopted December 30, 1948, be and the same hereby is amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 67. Contractors and Contracting.

Every person engaged in the business of a contractor or the occupation of contracting as defined in this chapter, in the City of Alexandria, and who has not paid a license tax in any other city or town in this state where he maintains a principal office or branch office, shall pay for the privilege of engaging in such business or occupation an annual license tax of \$25.00 and \$0.39 per \$100.00 of the gross receipts in excess of \$6,410.00 from all such business done within the state. Engaging in any of the following businesses or occupations shall also be deemed contracting, namely:

- Air conditioning
- Brick contracting, stone and other masonry
- Building
- Cement
- Dredging, sand, gravel
- Electrical
- Floor scraping or finishing
- Foundations
- Paint, paper decorating
- Plastering
- Plumbing, heating, steamfitting, gasfitting
- Road, street, bridge, sidewalk, curb and gutter
- Roofing
- Sewer drilling and well digging
- Structural metal
- Tile, glass, flooring, floor covering
- Wrecking, moving, excavating
- Other contractors and contracting

The provisions of this section are subject to the limitations contained in Section 176 of the State Tax Code.

2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette and it shall become effective the day after its publication. The clerk of the council shall note the time of publication upon the minutes of this meeting.
