

Ordinance No. 619

AN ORDINANCE to amend and re-enact Section 73, Chapter VII of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, as said Chapter VII is amended by Ordinance No. 521 adopted January 31, 1948 and Ordinance No. 564 adopted December 30, 1948, which said Chapter VII, as amended, relates to annual city license taxes, regulations and penalties, and which said section relates to slaughter houses and abbatoirs.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

1. That Section 73, Chapter VII of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, as said Chapter VII is amended by Ordinance No. 521 adopted January 31, 1948 and Ordinance No. 564 adopted December 30, 1948, be and the same hereby is amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 73. Slaughter House or Abbatoir.

Every person engaging in, conducting or operating a slaughter house or abbatoir in the City of Alexandria shall pay for the privilege an annual license tax of \$25.00 and \$0.21 per \$100.00 of the gross receipts therefrom in excess of \$11,904.00.

2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette and it shall become effective the day after its publication. The clerk of the council shall note the time of publication upon the minutes of this meeting.
