

Ordinance No. 623

AN ORDINANCE to vacate a portion of Old Cameron Mills Road, sixteen feet in width running from the East line of Alexandria-Leesburg Pike eastwardly along the North line of Ivy Hill Cemetery to Oakland Terrace, one of the public streets of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, acting pursuant to the laws provided for in such cases, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that said portion of Old Cameron Mills Road is not needed for public use and whereas it is in the public interest to vacate the same.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the portion of Old Cameron Mills Road in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, sixteen feet in width running from the East line of Alexandria-Leesburg Pike eastwardly along the North line of Ivy Hill Cemetery to Oakland Terrace, be and the same hereby is vacated, closed and abandoned as a public street and thoroughfare.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage.
