

Ordinance No. 625

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 1, Chapter XXI of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, which said chapter relates to sanitary privies or closets, regulations and penalties, and which said section relates to sanitary facilities in residences and buildings.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

1. That Section 1, Chapter XXI of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 1. Buildings must have sanitary water closet.

Every residence and building of the city in which human beings reside, are employed or congregate, shall have a sanitary water closet for the disposal of human excreta, except that in places where no trunk line or lateral line sewer is available a sanitary privy is permissible.

2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette and it shall become effective the day after its publication. The clerk of the council shall note the time of publication in the minutes of this meeting.
