

Ordinance No. 627

AN ORDINANCE to change the name of a certain public street, in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, now known as Potomac Street to Potomac Court.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

1. That the name of that certain public street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, within the block bounded by Wolfe, Union, Wilkes, and Lee Streets, running southwardly from the south side of Wolfe Street to a dead end and heretofore known as Potomac Street, be and the same hereby is changed to Potomac Court.

2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette and it shall become effective the day after its publication. The clerk of the Council shall note the time of publication upon the minutes of this meeting.
