

Ordinance No. 628

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 40, as amended, Chapter XI of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, which said chapter relates to traffic and said section relates to parking meter zones.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

1. That Section 40, as amended, Chapter XI of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 40. Parking Meter Zones Established.

The following described parts of the streets of the City of Alexandria are hereby established as parking meter zones:

(a) Both sides of King Street from Union Street to Commonwealth Avenue.

(b) Both sides of the 100 block north and the 100 block south of each street intersecting with King Street from Fairfax Street to West Street, both inclusive.

(c) Both sides of the 200 block North Washington Street and 200 block South Washington Street.

(d) Both sides of Cameron Street between Fairfax Street and Pitt Street, and both sides of Cameron Street between Columbus Street and Alfred Street; also the north side of Cameron Street between Pitt Street and St. Asaph Street.

(e) Both sides of Prince Street between St. Asaph Street and Columbus Street.

2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette and it shall become effective on the day after its publication. The clerk shall note the time of such publication upon the minutes of this meeting.
