

# Ordinance No. 631

AN ORDINANCE to amend Article II, Chapter XI of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, by adding a new section thereto numbered Section 52-A, which said Chapter XI relates to traffic, which said Article II relates to parking meters and which said new Section 52-A relates to persons interfering with enforcement.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

1. That Article II, Chapter XI of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940 be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new section thereto numbered Section 52-A to read as follows:

**Sec. 52-A. Persons interfering with enforcement.**

It shall be unlawful for any police officer, city official or employee, or any other person to remove or destroy any ticket or record on any violation of the sections of this article.

2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette and it shall become effective the day after its publication. The clerk of the council shall note the time of publication in the minutes of this meeting.
