

Ordinance No. 636

AN ORDINANCE to amend Chapter XXIII of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, by adding a new section thereto Numbered Section 6-A, which said Chapter XXIII relates to garbage, ashes, and trash, and which said Section 6-A relates to dumping.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

1. That Chapter XXIII of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940 be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new section thereto Numbered Section 6-A to read as follows:

Sec. 6-A. Dumping.

It shall be unlawful for any person to dump or to cause to be dumped on any City dump, any garbage, ashes or trash, which are brought into the City from any point outside of the City limits.

2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette not later than two (2) days following its introduction along with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication of said ordinance, the date of the public hearing; and the date of second reading and final passage in the minutes. This ordinance shall become effective the day of its final passage.
